Trenerkurset er tilpasset korona situasjonen med mer online jobbing og e-læring enn det ordinære kurset, men gir samme kompetanse.

Dette er et samarbeid med ECB (England and Wales Cricketboard) som arrangerer kurset og det finske og norske cricketforbundet.

Norge har en begrensning på 11 deltakere. Finland har en begrensning på 7 deltakere.
