# Player Eligibility & Team Selection

# Player Eligibility Regulations

The same Eligibility Regulations apply to ICC Events as T20 Internationals.

1. The player was born in the country (as evidenced by official birth certificate or title page of **passport**)
2. At the date of squad submission, the player is a national of the country as evidenced by his possession of a valid **passport** issued by the relevant country  
(See Note 1)
3. At the date of squad submission, the player is a permanent resident of the country and has been **physically present within the country for at least 10 months in each of the previous 3 years** (See Note 2)

If a player cannot explicitly meet any of the above three criteria, they will be considered ineligible. An Exceptional Circumstances application can be submitted, but exceptional circumstances must exist as to why the player cannot meet / has not met the Criteria.

# Accommodation

- Each team will be accommodated at the St Pierre Park Hotel, Guernsey.
- ICC will cover accommodation from the evening Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> August until departure on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> August.
- Each team will be provided 2 single rooms (Coach and Manager) and 7 twin rooms (14 players sharing). Accommodation will include daily breakfast as standard.
- Any additional room requirements will be at the cost of each Member, and payment must be arranged directly with GCB or the Hotel.

Please advise of any additional room requests no later than Monday 6<sup>th</sup> June, and we will do our best to accommodate this.

- Laundry will be provided on 4 days during the Event.

It is strongly recommended that all teams bring two playing kits per person in case of any issues in returning laundry overnight.

# Catering

- All breakfasts and match day lunches will be provided during the Event.
- All dinners and non-match day lunches will be the cost and responsibility of Members.
- ICC will provide at-match water requirements to players and officials. Any required snacks or sports drinks will be at the cost and responsibility of participating countries.
- All teams are expected to bring individual, named drink bottles for all players and officials to fill via the facilities provided at the grounds.

Any dietary requirements must be advised by Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2022 using the template provided by ICC.

# Live Streaming

- The U19 Qualifiers are not included within ICC's live streaming arrangements with IMG. As such, this Event is not scheduled to be live streamed.
- However, a videographer will be contracted to produce highlights, match clips and editorial content throughout the event.
