

ICC 2020 U19 CWC – EUROPE DIVISION 2 QUALIFIER CONSENT FORM FOR MINORS (TO BE COMPLETED BY PARENTS/GUARDIANS)

The ICC 2020 U19 CWC Qualifier – Europe Division 2 scheduled to take place in Essex, England between July 29 and August 10 2018, (the “**Event**”) is sanctioned by the International Cricket Council (the “**ICC**”) and is organized by the ICC’s wholly-owned subsidiary, ICC Business Corporation FZ LLC.

All players participating in the Event are subject to certain ICC Regulations (including the ICC Code of Conduct for Players and Player Support Personnel; the ICC Anti-Racism Code for Players and Player Support Personnel; the ICC Anti-Doping Code; the ICC Anti-Corruption Code for Participants; the Player Eligibility Regulations; Minimum Standards for Players’ and Match Officials’ Areas; and the ICC Clothing and Equipment Rules and Regulations).

If your child will be under 18 years of age on July 29 2018, as their parent or legal guardian, you must complete and sign this form. Please note that your child will be deemed to be ineligible to participate in the Event until the properly completed and signed form has been received in accordance with the instructions set out below.

You hereby expressly consent, in connection with the Event:

- (i) to the possibility that your child may be selected to provide a urine sample for the purposes of anti-doping analysis pursuant to the ICC Anti-Doping Code and, if selected to provide a sample, to the taking of such urine sample from your child in accordance with the procedures set out in the ICC Anti-Doping Code;
- (ii) to your child being photographed and/or filmed in both on-the-field and off-the-field activities as part of the broadcast of matches comprising the Event and otherwise as part of the ICC’s official publicity activities;
- (iii) to your child receiving any urgent medical treatment deemed necessary by a suitably qualified medical practitioner in the event that the ICC is unable to make contact with you; and
- (iv) to your child’s participation in the Event being subject to the ICC’s Squad Terms (as provided by your national cricket authority) and you agree to ensure your child’s compliance with them.

By signing this form, you are also confirming that your child has adequate insurance to cover their participation in the Event.

Please note that if your child is taking any medications then you should discuss this with your national cricket authority to determine whether it is necessary to apply for a Therapeutic Use Exemption in order to comply with the ICC Anti-Doping Code.
